4. Chair's Remarks

Chair wished everyone a happy new year and thanked them for attending the meeting
The street identification signs for Millbrook Court in Little Mill been replaced following a report that they were heavily faded.

5. County Councillor Participation

Meirion Howells Reported:

Cae Melin Road in Little Mill has been adopted by Monmouthshire County Council

Flood mitigation works opposite Island House in Usk – Community funded pump?

A quotation for around £9000 has been circulated for the replacement of the wooden bus shelter in Monkswood which was burnt down in an arson attack in 2024. MCC does not currently have funds to replace the structure and is looking to apply to Active Travel and Welsh Government for available funding. The bus stop is still active despite there being no shelter.

Appropriate legal action is being undertaken regarding the site at Little Mill with MCC's enforcement team.

Road re-surfacing will be taking place on the A472 soon which may cause some disruption with road traffic.

Tony Kear Reported:

Marked trees in Llanbadoc – It has been identified that the trees which have been marked for tree works near and around St. Madocs Church are the responsibility of MCC. The works are due to take place in February and there may be short term road closures (estimated 15-30 minutes each time) whilst trees are felled and removed.

A local resident who expressed an interest in carrying out a litter pick at Llanbadoc Island was advised by another individual that appropriate insurance would not be in place. LCC has insurance

which would cover a litter pick providing that a risk assessment is carried out and submitted to LCC prior to the pick going ahead. **Action: Tony Kear: Take this information back to the individual.**

Tony Kear has spoken to the proprietor of The Little Jockey provisionally about further discussions about keeping the pub open. The proprietor has agreed to a 'coffee chat' to discuss further options with members of the community who wish to see the pub remain open.

Flooding at Little Mill: The first instance of flooding was identified to be coming from a blocked culvert in the corner of the pub car park, this has now been cleared by the property owner.

The second instance of flooding was found to be caused by a pipe under a roadway which is the responsibility of Network Rail. The pipe has now been unblocked and added to the annual maintenance schedule of Network Rail.

The MCC draft budget has been announced today (14.01.2024) with a Council Tax increase of 6.8%

The Chair noted that Millbrook Court (Leading to Ty Gwyn Road) in Little Mill was not salted during the frost period over Christmas. It was not clear who would have been responsible carrying out salting in the area. Tony Kear noted this comment.
